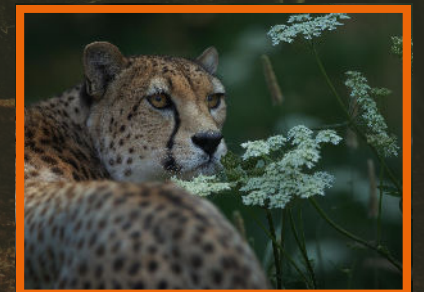

Pupils should be taught to: Identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals. Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals, including pets).

Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats.
