Dartmoor Zoo is a 33-acre site located on the fringes of Dartmoor, Devon.

Dartmoor Zoological Society, the charity behind the Zoo was established in 2014 when Benjamin Mee, the former private owner of the Zoo, gifted it to the newly formed charity.

Today the Zoo is heavily involved in research, conservation, and education projects to promote the welfare of animals and to enrich both the lives of humans and animals.

At the heart of all Dartmoor Zoo's activities is conservation. By improving conservation through research and breeding, the Zoo is finding ways to help animal numbers and habitats, it's investigating ways to protect the environment and identifying means by which humans and nature can interact to create better health and well-being.

Dartmoor Zoo's work helps to enrich people's lives by encouraging volunteering, training, and education. Dartmoor Zoo's research department works alongside keepers to design ideas for animal welfare and enrichment, evaluating their success with the animals to provide continual improvements.

Coach drivers receive free admission and a hot drink voucher.

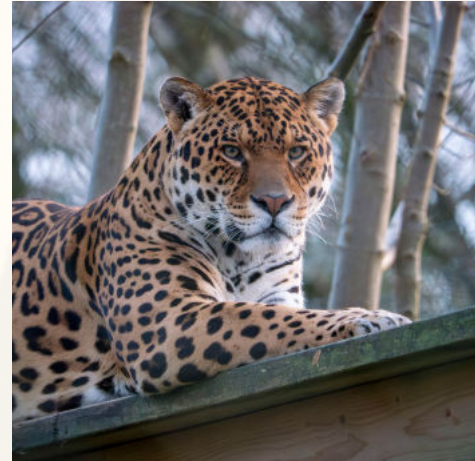


MEET THE TIGER
