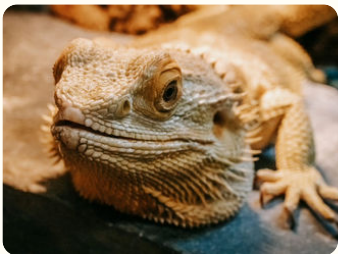


Close Encounters **Suitable for all learning levels.**
