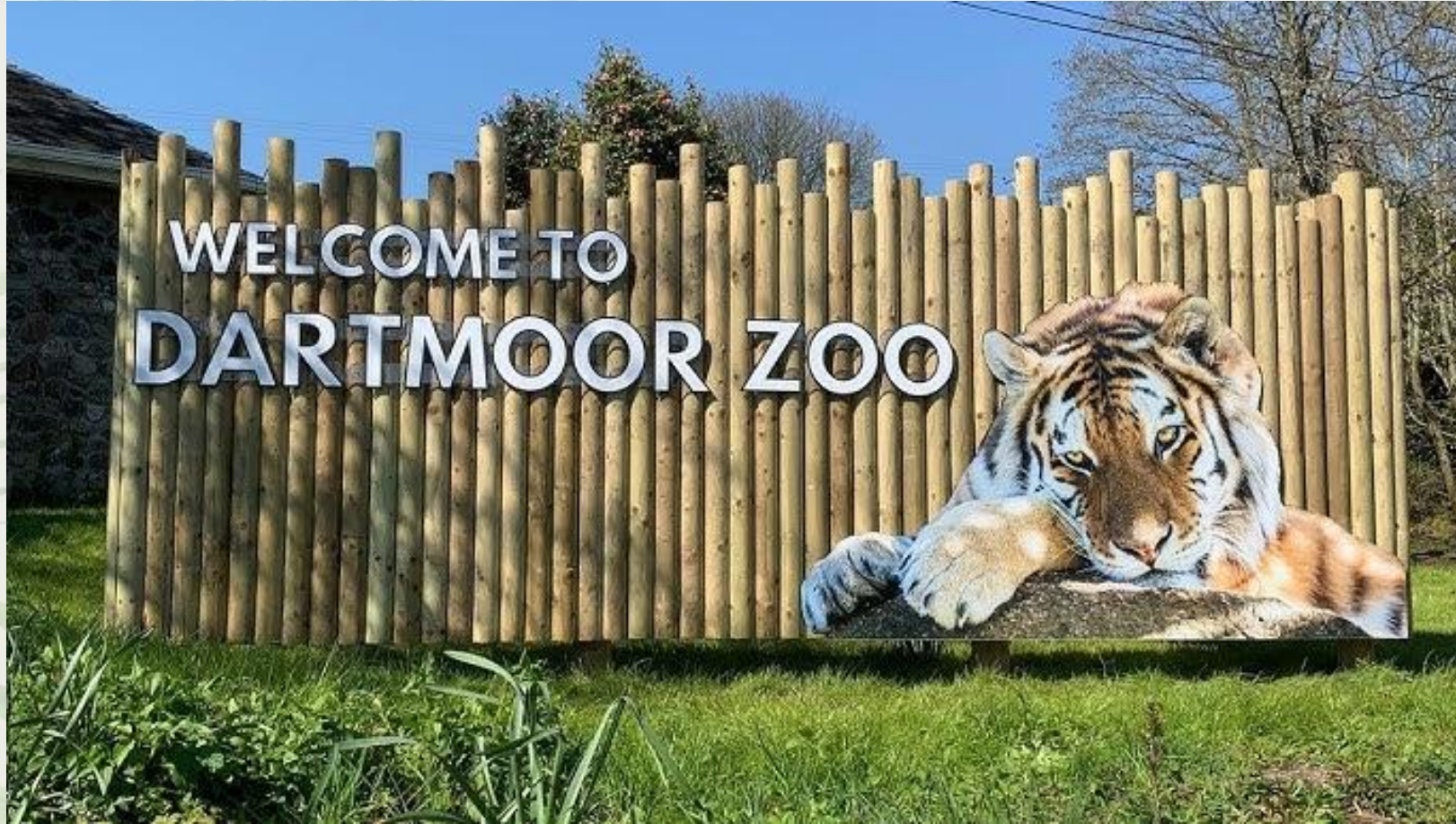




This is the sign I

Your workshop will be in one of our two classrooms

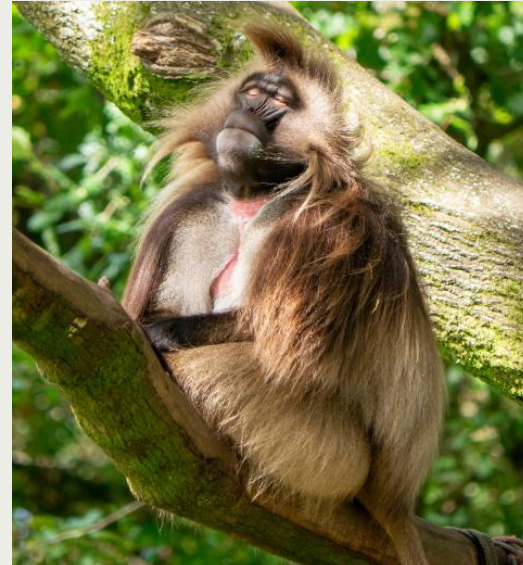


If I am going to a workshop, I will go in to one of these rooms with my classmates to learn with Jo, Andy, Kate or Izzy.

Hopefully, I will see lots of wonderful animals during my visit.

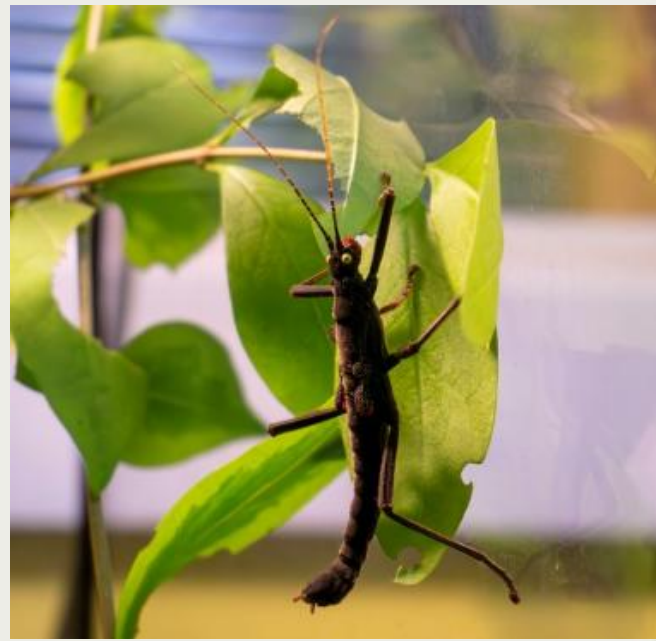
I will do my best to be quiet and calm because some of them can be shy! This will help me to see more of them.
